# Countdown Christmas 

Finished Quilt Size: 32" $\times 44^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

- 15 fat quarters, or more for variety, for pockets and pieced border in red, aqua, green and cream
- 1 yard white for sashing, first border and piecing
- 1 ½ yards for backing
- $1 / 2$ yard for binding
- Fusible web for appliqué numbers
- Foundation paper for piecing border and blocks


## CUTTING

Assorted fabrics:

- (17) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for pocket front
- (24) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares for pocket facing
- (24) $41 / 2$ " $\times 5$ " rectangles for pocket back


## White fabric:

- (5) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35^{\prime \prime}$ crosswise strips for vertical sashing and side borders
- (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26 \frac{112 "}{\prime \prime}$ crosswise strips for top and bottom borders
- (3) $2^{\prime \prime}$ crosswise strips, cut into (20) 2 " $\times 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ for horizontal sashing


## ASSEMBLY

Each block is a pocket. They consist of a front, a facing and a back. Some of the pocket fronts are foundation pieced and others have appliquéd numbers.

Step 1: Print the seven foundation patterns on foundation paper.

Step 2: Piece the blocks.
Step 3: Appliqué the numbers on the 17 pocket fronts. Trace and fuse numbers to pockets. Stitch edge with zigzag or blanket stitch. Use the photo to see what numbers we left out ( $3,5,10,16,17,19$, and 24) or you can decide which numbers to replace with the 7 pieced blocks.
Step 4: Put pocket front and pocket facing right sides together. Stitch across top with $1 / 4$ " seam. Press seam open, then press facing down to back.

Step 5: Place the lined pocket on top of pocket back matching bottom and side raw edges. Baste sides and bottom close to the edge.


Step 4


Place front of pocket onto facing and stitch 1/4" seam across top.

Step 5


Place lined pocket on top of backing. Aline bottom edges and baste sides and bottom.

Step 6


Arrange blocks in order.

Step 7


Join blocks in vertical columns then connect columns together.

## OUTSIDE BORDERS

Step 11: Foundation piece the outside borders. Note that the top and bottom border blocks are a slightly different size from the side border blocks. Be sure to mark them so they do not get mixed.
Step 12: Foundation piece the four corner blocks.
Step 13: Sew the six side blocks together. Press the seams open.

Step 14: Sew the four top and four bottom blocks together.

Step 15: Add the corner blocks to the ends of the top and bottom borders.

Step 16: Join the side borders to the center of the quilt.
Step 17: Add the top and bottom borders with corners to the quilt.

Step 18: Layer the quilt with backing.
Step 19: Quilt the quilt.
Step 20: Bind with 2 " strips for double binding.
Step 21: Add a little gift to each pocket.
Step 22: Celebrate!
