Fabrics:
Fat quarter of toile for center square
1½ yards assorted light fabric
$1 / 4$ yard assorted medium fabric
11/2 yards assorted dark fabric
$1 / 2$ yard neutral background (center corner triangles)
$1 / 2$ yard assorted light greens (border 1)
$21 / 8$ yards large floral for border
$3 / 4$ yard for binding
4 yards backing
Cutting directions:
Toile fat quarter:

- cut $81 / 2$ " square (center)

Assorted lights:

- (24) $21 / 2$ " squares (center)
- (4) $71 / 4$ " squares cut twice diagonally to yield (16) quarter-square triangles (border 2)
- (4) $3^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut once diagonally to yield (8) half-square triangles (border 2)
- (4) $31 / 2$ " squares (border 2)
- (14) $71 / 4$ " squares cut twice diagonally to yield (56) triangles (border 4)
- (8) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut once diagonally to yield (16) half-square triangles (border 4)


## Assorted mediums:

- (24) $21 / 2$ " squares (center)

Assorted darks:

- (5) $71 / 4$ " squares cut twice diagonally to yield
(20) quarter-square triangles (border 2)
- (24) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " rectangles (border 3)
- (4) $31 / 2$ " squares (border 3)
- (32) $43 / 4$ " squares (border 4)


## Neutral background:

- (2) $12^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut once diagonally to yield (4) corner triangles (center)

Assorted light greens:

- (12) $31 / 2$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (border 1)
- (12) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares ( border 1)


## Large floral:

- (7) strips 7" x wof (border 5)


## Binding fabric:

- (8) strips $21 / 2 " \times$ wof (binding)


## Construction:

## Center medallion:

1. For the center medallion, make (12) four-patch units from the assorted $21 / 2$ " light and medium squares.
2. Join (2) sets of four-patches and sew to opposite sides of the center square. Sew (4) four-patches to the other two sides.
3. Sew large neutral triangles to the corners. Triangles are oversized.
4. Trim center block to a $241 / 2$ " square.

## Border 1:

1. Sew green rectangles and squares together to make (4) 24112 "border strips.
2. Sew borders to sides of center medallion. Add $31 / 2$ " squares to the ends of the two remaining borders and add to top and bottom of center.

## Border 2:

1. Lay out 4 light and 5 dark quarter-square triangles. Add two light half-square triangles to each end to complete border. Make (4) borders. Sew one border strip to each side.
2. Add a light square to each end of remaining border 2 strips and add to top and bottom of center.

## Border 3:

1. Sew (6) assorted dark rectangles together end to end. Make four strips. Sew border to sides of center.
2. Add dark $31 / 2$ " square to ends of remaining strips and add to top and bottom of center.

## Border 4:

1. Lay out (7) dark $43 / 4$ " squares and (6) pairs of assorted light quarter-square triangles. Piece the triangles to the squares in diagonal rows. Add two half-square triangles to each end to complete a border. Make two and join these as the side borders.
2. Lay out (9) dark 43/4" squares and (8) pairs of assorted light quarter-square triangles. Add a pair of half-square triangles to each end to complete the top and bottom borders. Join to the quilt.

## Border 5:

1. Piece the floral strips to make (2) borders $541 / 2 " \times 7$ " and (2) borders $671 / 2 " \times 7$ ". Add borders to sides of quilt first, then to top and bottom.

## Finishing:

Layer with backing and quilt. Bind quilt with $21 / 2$ " binding strips.
