

Peel & Stick Fabric Daisy

Step 1: Print

Prepare your image or text on your computer.

- Scan in a photo or other image
- Use your own digital photos
- Or create a design using software

If you are using a preprinted fabric sheet, move on to Step 2.



Step 5: Stick

Take another petal shape and peel off the backing. Place it on top of the other petal sticky side to sticky side, sandwiching the wire in between.



Step 2: Trace

Trace the petal shape on the back of the Peel & Stick Fabric Sheet. Use one of the templates provided or draw your own.

The number of petals needed is up to you. Just remember you will need two cutouts for each completed petal.



Step 6: Twist

Once you have created all of your petals, wrap the wires together. Cut off any excess wire.



Step 3: Cut

Cut out the petal shapes.



Step 7: Shape

The wire makes the flowers hold their shape so bend the petals any way you'd like. Glue a button in the center to finish the daisy.



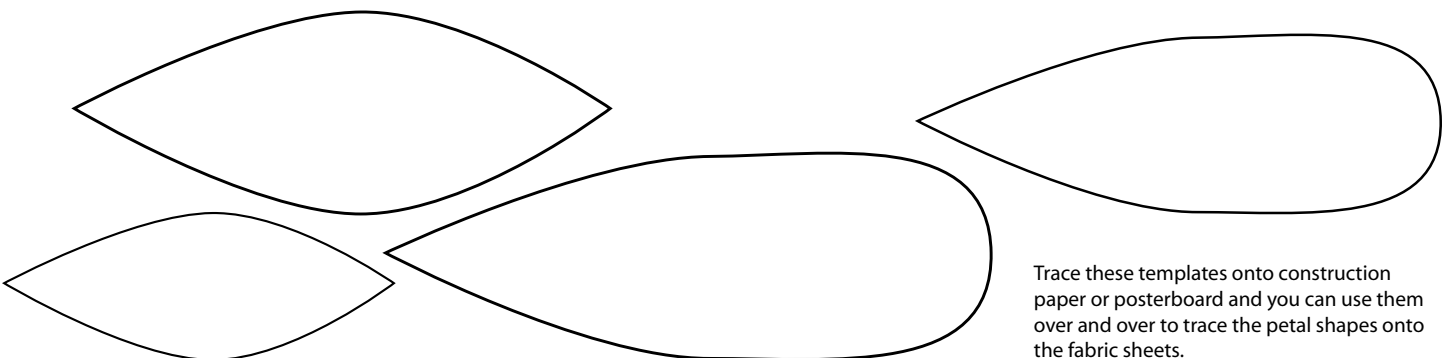
Step 4: Peel & Wire

Peel off the backing and place a wire in the middle of the petal. Be sure to cut the wire long enough to leave a tail for wrapping the petals together later.



Step 8: Optional

Add a pin back to the flower to make it into a beautiful brooch. Or add a stem and leaves and give someone a flower that will last forever.



Trace these templates onto construction paper or posterboard and you can use them over and over to trace the petal shapes onto the fabric sheets.
